Online Sign Up & Registration at Track

1. Online Sign Up is open until midnight Thursday, April 30th, 2009
2. Online Pre-Registration must be paid by any Credit Card.
3. Post registration (Tower) accepts all Credit Cards & cash only. **NO CHECKS.**
4. Pre-Entry riders (this include parent/guardian if rider is a minor) MUST check in at Registration (Tower) to sign releases.
5. ALL RIDERS must be present at registration.
6. All riders (Pre & Post Entries) must report to tower to receive practice sticker.

7. A rider will NOT be allowed on track without a practice sticker and armband.
8. Organized Practice rider must practice with designated group.
9. Minors with Guardian must have two copies of "notarized" statements for Guardian to be able to sign for minor.
10. Riders MUST bring AMA card & last 4 digits of VIN number of every bike competing on to registration.

Other Oak Hill Information:

- Age Effective: January 1, 2009
- RV Hook-Ups \$25/day first come first serve.
- Bike Washing ONLY allowed in YOUR PIT.
- No bike washing in the open RV site next to yours. Please be thoughtful of those coming in for the next day of race.
- FM Broadcast 89.1FM (Bring Your Walkman or Portable Radio).
- 40+ A/B is a Trophy only class.
- No Pit Bike riding.
- Must be 18 and hold a valid drivers license to drive Golf Karts or Utility Vehicle. No Pit Bikes or ATV's (4-Wheelers) allowed.
- All Pit Vehicles must be parked by 10:00pm.

Oak Hill Raceway Rules

- PIT RIDING PROHIBITED
- ALL PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH
- RIDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS
- OAK HILL RACEWAY STAFF DECISIONS ARE FINAL
- MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE TO OPERATE A PIT VEHICLE (MULE OR GOLF CART only NO 4-WHEELERS)
- CAMP FIRES PROHIBITED
- EVERY PERSON ON THE OAK HILL MX PARK PROPERTY MUST SIGN A RELEASE OF LIABILITY WAIVER OR WILL BE CONSIDERED A TRESPASSER
- RIDERS MAY RIDE THEIR RACE BIKES TO THE STAGING AREA IN 1ST GEAR ONLY
- EXCLUDING THE FRONT ENTRY GATE, IF YOU ARE GOING THROUGH A GATE, OPEN OR CLOSED, YOU'RE GOING SOMEWHERE YOU'RE NOT SUPPOSED TO BE. AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY!
- RIDERS UNDER 18 YEARS OLD MUST HAVE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OR NOTARIZED RELEASE TO RACE. RELEASE WILL BE KEPT BY THE TRACK
